HOSTEL CODE OF CONDUCT

General Conduct

- Respect the rights of fellow residents.
- Take care of college property and respect others' belongings.
- Avoid activities that disrupt normal college operations.
- Always carry your identity card and present it when requested by an authorized college official.
- Ensure that your guests follow all college policies and behave appropriately.
- Maintain silence during study and night hours (10:00 PM 6:00 AM).
- During exams, maintain a quiet environment at all times.
- Students must comply with requests from co-residents to reduce noise levels.
- Ragging is strictly prohibited, and any violation will result in severe disciplinary action.

Discipline

- Students are not allowed to keep money or credit/debit cards with them and the college does not permit cash handling.
- Electronic gadgets such as mobile phones, iPods, and radios are not allowed on campus.
- Leaving the campus without permission from the principal or administrative in-charge is strictly prohibited.
- Any student engaging in anti-social behavior may face serious disciplinary action, including expulsion.
- Immoral acts will result in immediate expulsion without reconsideration.
- Possession of inappropriate reading or viewing material is strictly prohibited.
- Overstaying leave will result in a fine as determined by the college.
- Buying, selling, or lending money or goods among students, staff, or outsiders is not allowed.
- Intoxication of any kind (alcohol, smoking, or drugs) is strictly prohibited and will lead to immediate expulsion.

- To maintain equality, students should avoid bringing expensive food items from home.
- Food parcels from outside will not be accepted or delivered to students.

Leave Policy

- Students can take leave only on designated days as per the college calendar.
- Parents/guardians must personally collect their children to foster communication with the college staff.
- No student is allowed to leave alone or with friends unless a prior written request from parents is submitted. Telephonic requests will not be accepted.
- Special leave of two days plus travel time may be granted for the marriage of a student's or parent's sibling.
- Leave may be granted in case of serious illness or bereavement in the immediate family.
- Medical leave requires certification from a qualified physician.
- Parents/guardians may visit only on designated visiting weekends as per the college calendar.

Dress Code

- Students must dress appropriately for classes, labs, sports, and cultural activities.
- Casual clothing is allowed after 5:00 PM, but it must be decent and tidy.
- For jogging and sports, students must wear appropriate sports attire (vest and shorts).
- Formal dress is required for classes and official events, including a formal shirt (subtle colors), formal trousers, black leather shoes, black socks, a black belt, and an optional black sweater.
- The following are not permitted;
 - Work shirts, polo shirts, sleeveless shirts, tight pants, Bermuda shorts, slippers, sandals, or bathroom chappals.
 - Hair must be neatly trimmed; dyeing or coloring is not allowed.
 - Tattoos are not permitted.

General Rules

- Parents must inform the college in writing of any changes in their address, email, or phone number.
- Parents visiting the college should report to the office.
- Valuables such as jewelry, cameras, and electronic devices should not be given to students, as the college is not responsible for loss or damage.
- The college reserves the right to monitor students' letters for their well-being.
- Money orders will not be accepted by the college.

- Any complaints, suggestions, or queries must be addressed to the principal, mentioning the student's name, class, and roll number.
- A suggestion/grievance box is available for parents to share feedback.
- Verbal commitments from staff or parents are not considered official; all communication should be in writing.
- Parents are not allowed to tip staff members or give them gifts.
- The college campus is a **strictly no-smoking zone**; visitors must refrain from smoking or consuming alcohol.
- Visitors are not allowed in the hostel rooms without prior permission from the administrator and supervision by a staff member.
- The college reserves the right to amend these rules at any time without prior notice.

Library Rules

- The library is open daily from 8:30 AM to 5:00 PM.
- Students can borrow a maximum of two books at a time using their borrower's card.
- Books can be issued for one week and may be renewed for an additional week if required. The librarian has the right to recall any book.
- Late returns will result in a fine.
- Previous issues of periodicals may be borrowed for two days.
- In case of loss or damage, students must either replace the book or reimburse its cost.
- Writing on or damaging library books is prohibited and will require replacement.
- After reading, books/periodicals should be placed back on their designated shelves.
- Reference books are for in-library use only and cannot be checked out.
- All borrowed books must be returned before the annual exams for a no-due certificate.
- Silence must be maintained in the library. Discussions are not allowed.
- Students should not bring personal belongings into the library, except notebooks.
- The librarian is not responsible for the loss of students' personal belongings.
